For other equipment :

- Batteries < 100Wh
 - integrated into the equipment: limited to 15 units in the hold and cabin⁽¹⁾ per person
 - spare batteries: **FORBIDDEN in the hold** and limited to 20 units in the cabin⁽¹⁾ and reduced to 2 units in the case of invertible batteries up to 12V
 - Batteries > 100Wh < 160Wh: **Prior agreement from the company**
 - integrated into the equipment: refer to the airline's agreement
 - Spare batteries or PowerBank type: **FORBIDDEN in hold** and refer to airline agreement for cabin rule
- Batteries > 160Wh: **FORBIDDEN in hold and cabin**

The above examples are only a selection of the devices potentially involved.

In accordance with the IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations, these devices may only be transported as freight.
